

In response to stated mission, vision and aims, the Board expects schools to be effective, engaging and caring learning communities.

The Superintendent/CEO will:

- 12.1 Ensure that programs and services are in compliance with provincial requirements.
- 12.2 Implement assessment and evaluation practices which:
  - a) Ensure the achievement of provincial, division and school goals;
  - b) Foster an effective and efficient school system;
  - c) Promote growth and improvement of personnel.
- 12.3 Establish and enforce administrative procedures to maintain safe and effective environments for all students and staff.
- 12.4 Establish a dispute resolution process to be followed if there is disagreement about the appropriateness of the educational programming being provided to a student by the Division.
- 12.5 Take appropriate action with staff, students or volunteers who demonstrate behaviours, actions, or attitudes that threaten the academic progress and/or well-being of students.
- 12.6 Encourage a culture characterized by mutual respect.
- 12.7 Promote the use of sound pedagogy in instructional practices.
